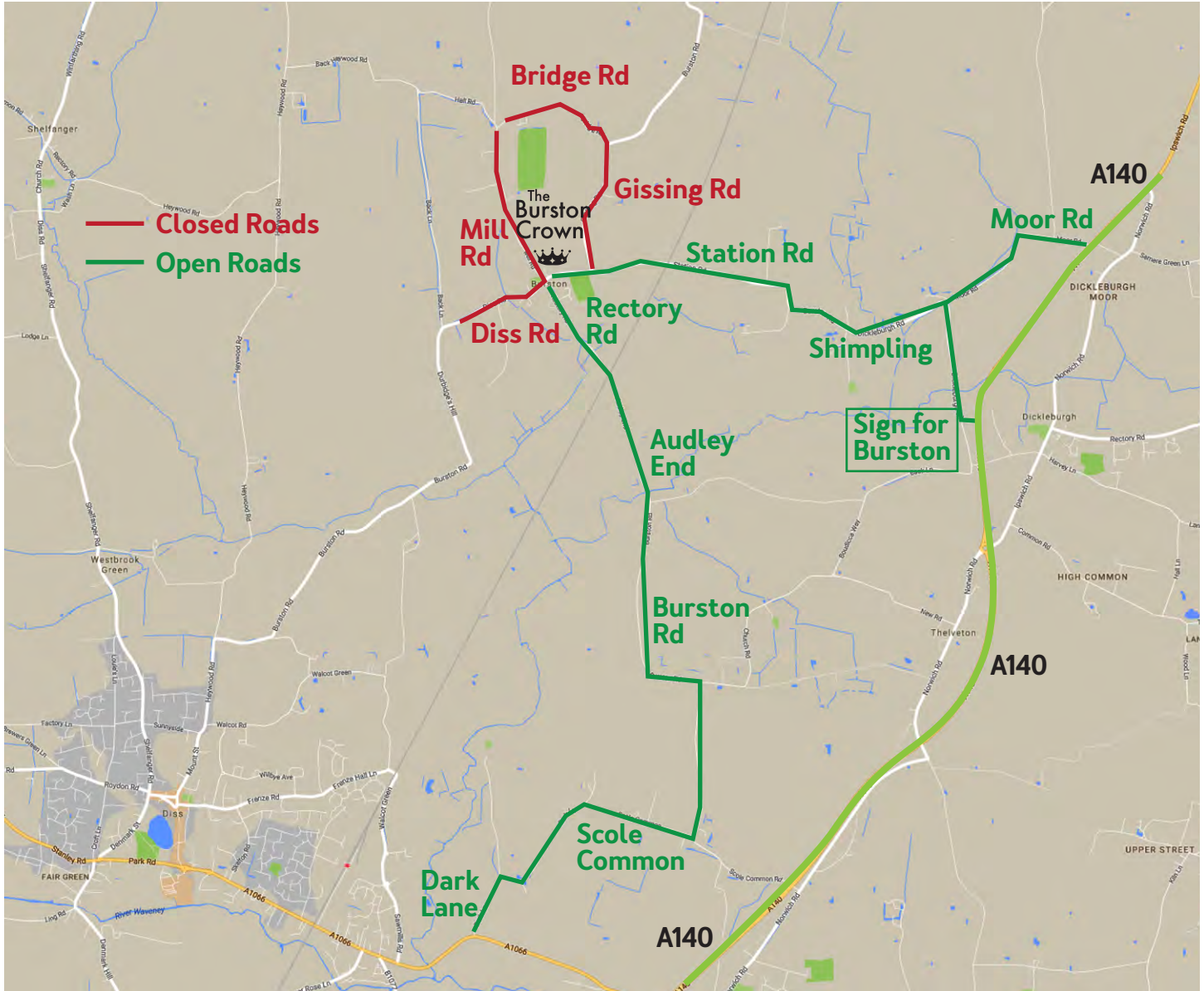


# The Burston Crown

## Sunday Road Closures



Due to over running work in Burston, Anglia Water has to close certain roads around the village each Sunday from 5th November for a few weekends.

This means that you may have to use different ways to reach your favourite pub. There will be signs at junctions and comfort signs every now and then, so you will know you are on the correct road.

### From Diss:

The scenic route:

Drive towards Scole past Desiras garage and turn left into Dark Lane. You will see signs at each junction to guide you to the Burston Crown.

### The A140:

If you continue onto the A140 and head towards Norwich you will cross the Dickleburgh roundabout

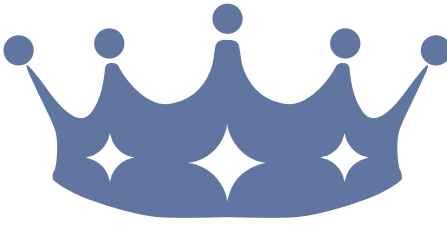
and see signs to turn left to the Burston Crown. You will drive through the historic village of Shimpling and arrive into Burston, passing the school on your left, the pub is on your right.

### From Shelfanger and Winfarthing:

You will need to drive onto the Long Row and head to the A140. Turning south onto the A140 you will see signs to The Burston Crown at Moor Road. You will drive through the historic village of Shimpling and arrive into Burston, passing the school on your left, the pub is on your right.

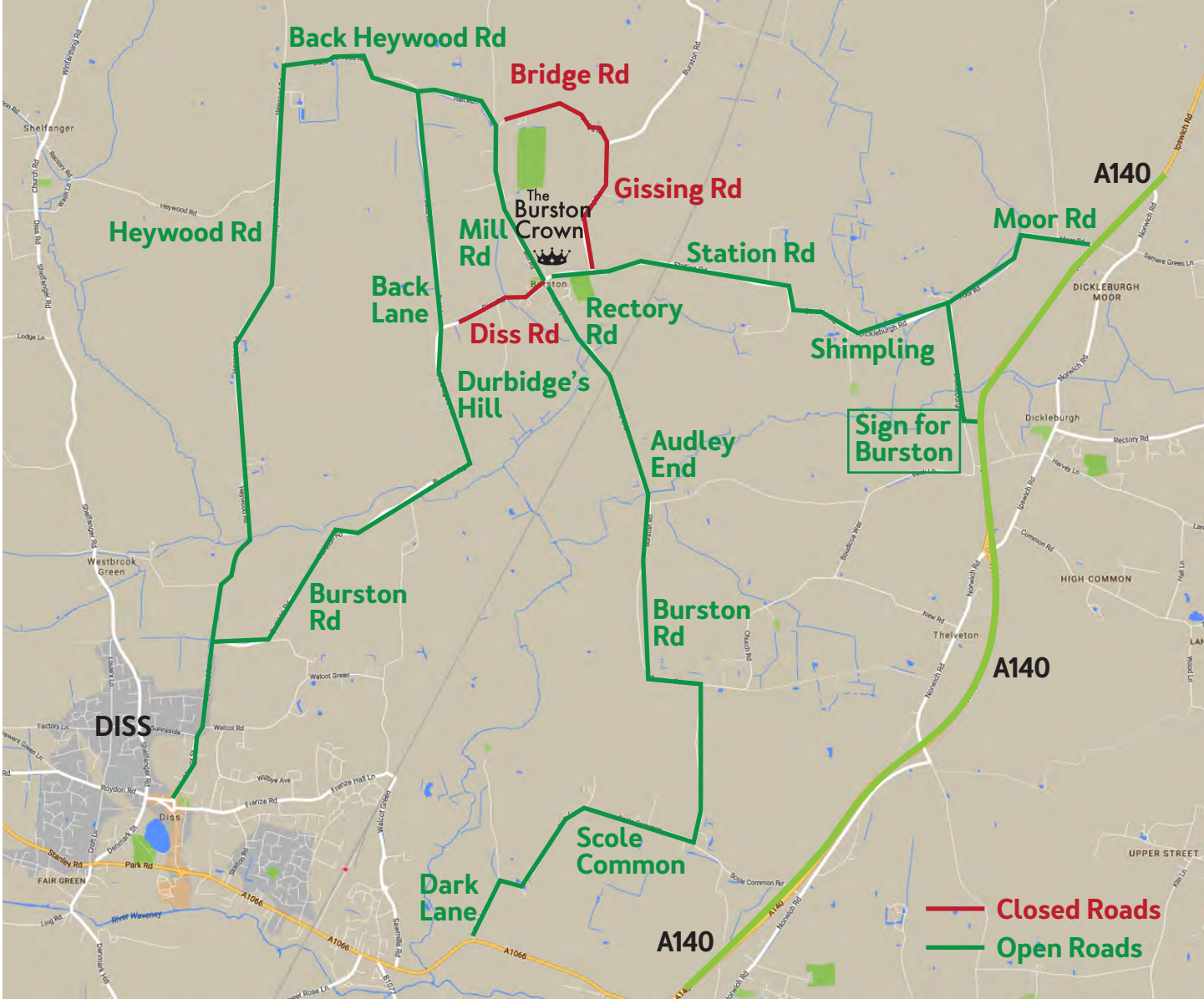
### From Scole and Dickleborough:

Follow the A140 instructions above.

### From Diss:

The road between Diss and Burston will be closed from November 2nd. To reach your favourite pub you will need to take a short scenic diversion, and possibly pick up some fresh eggs at the roadside stall on the way. Following the road signs you will take the Heywood Road to Back Heywood Road and and the signs will take you to The Burston Crown.
